Series 2 will cover similarities and differences between music therapy, music education and music in the classroom and why music is an effective tool for learning.

3. Understand the similarities and differences within music therapy, music education and classroom music applications.
4. Identify theories and principles related to music

Series 3 will show how to incorporate music into classroom settings for a variety of ages and available resources.

Learner Objectives:

5. Identify the 5 uses of music in therapy and provide examples of application to classroom settings
6. Identify resources for using music with students who have special needs

Series 4 is a closing summary of the course with client vignettes, research highlights and how music therapists can support students and educators.
